*The Manor Conservancy was founded in 1993 as a non profit private land trust. It has been involved with numerous projects resulting in the conservation of farmland, forests and historic landmarks and districts in Northern Baltimore and Harford Counties*

The Conservancy has been the primary force behind the preservation of more than 17,000 acres in northern Baltimore & Harford counties. TMC was part of the team that designed one of the most progressive agricultural zoning classifications in the country. It has procured numerous conservation easements, helped organize and served in leadership capacities in the Baltimore County Landmarks Preservation Commission, obtained landmark status for the towns of Monkton & Corbett & individual landmarks. It was responsible for My Lady's Manor's listing on the National Register of Historic Places. TMC also arranged for the purchase and subsequent conservation of several large farms in danger of development and protected Hess Corner. It continues to work closely with Maryland Environmental Trust, Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation, Rural Legacy Program & Baltimore & Harford Counties to further conservation goals.
